BACK IN THE SADDLE

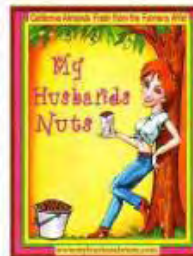
Artist Rygh Westby knows his subject—cowboying. He knows the cowboy life as he has worked on outfits all over the Rockies and a number of large ones in Wyoming and Montana. In fact, it was while he was cowboying on the historic Padlock Ranch in Montana that he sold his first painting. That was 1976. The sale of that painting was inspirational and has led Rygh (pronounced *Rig*) on to a career depicting the cowboy and his ways. The subjects for Westby's art are mostly the men he has worked with. The same is true of the horses and gear he depicts. Westby's art is in private and museum collections including the Buffalo Bill Museum, Museum of the Rockies, Museum of the Big Bend, and the Bradford Benton Memorial and Museum in Big Horn, Wyoming.

NATURAL BEAUTY

Those large stones or rock outcroppings on the ranch could become works of art. Naturally recognized bronze and stone sculptor Austin Casson of Temecula, California, has been transforming local stone into life-size creations. This piece, called *The Sentinel*, was sculpted from a local rock that weighed in at 130,000 pounds and overlooks the Lone Oak Ranch of Don and Boise Taylor. Preliminary designs are first drawn on the raw stone. Casson then sculpts with hammers, chisels, power cutters, and grinders. His stone creations have been whimsical Thelwell-type ponies in California to a sleeping grizzly bear in Montana. "Stone is the ultimate challenge," says Casson. "There is little room for error and the results will have a thousand years of critics."

He spends time with patrons to discover their interests and presents designs that will fit the stone. Casson's bronze eagle *Cry Freedom* was presented to former President George H.W. Bush, and his works are on permanent display at the World Golf Hall of Fame.
